### Monday

#### Knappensteig Trail: Silver mining and Adlerblick

Along the trails of former mines, Otto guides you past the dark holes of the Knappensteig Trail and up into the magnificent landscape of Kaunertal. Equipped with a helmet and a flashlight, everyone can have a go at digging for silver in the rock. Then it's up to the "Adlerblick" observation platform. Constructed on a cliff more than 100 metres above Feichten, this platform offers the perfect view across this kingdom of 3000-m peaks!

#### Hiking over the glacier tongue

Well equipped with ropes, crampons and belts, you get a unique glimpse into the world of endless ice. The mountain guide leads you across millennia-old ice fields right up to the glacier tongue.

#### Fernergries climbing garden

Great fun on steep walls for children, either with or without parents. Secured on a rope by a Kaunertal mountain guide, climb and rappel on a beautiful granite surface at our climbing garden at the rear of the Kaunertal valley. On Wednesdays we will grill sausage - please bring enough to drink!

#### Holderli-Seppl via ferrata

A gorgeous via ferrata leads participants up an exciting route at the edge of the cascading waterfall in the Riffelbach gorge. Surrounded by stone pines, climb up glittering Gneiss stone.

### Thursday

#### The red cliffs of Fernergries

Otto the mountain guide will lead you from Oberbirg up into high alpine terrain. The hike will take you over steep tracks off the beaten path, along the wild glacial stream right up to the glacier tongue. You'll be led back via the glittering red cliffs of Fernergries.

### Friday

#### Family-friendly adventure day through the Gallruth tunnel

The dark Gallruth tunnel is 990 metres long. The tunnel was hewn into the rock many years ago in order to access a valuable source of water for the ridges of the Kaunerberg mountain. This torch-lit trail is only for the courageous and our hiking guide will share the history and legends of the region along the way. Finally, at the end of the tunnel, guests will enter the fairy-tale high valley where a trail leads to the dramatically situated Gallruthalm Alpine hut after approx. 30 minutes. Here we will stop for refreshments and enjoy the magnificent views and fresh mountain air. Afterwards, we will hike along the Dr. Angerer high-Alpine trail back to the Falkaunsalm Alpine hut. Adults must accompany children. Food and drink are available from both Alpine huts.
